



PICNIC WITH PRIDE FAQs

Where is Picnic with Pride being held?

The picnic will be held on the private West Lawn at Malahide Castle & Gardens

How much are the tickets?

Tickets are €35 per person applicable for child or adult. Suitable for 16's and over, under 18's must be accompanied by an adult. Tickets are limited in line with government guidelines.

What is included in the ticket?

Entry to West Lawn and allocated picnic spot, meat and cheese grazing box and glass of prosecco on arrival, entertainment from Malahide Woman (James Patrice), proceeds of your ticket going to Community Foundation for Ireland.

What time does it start?

It starts at 7pm. Tickets and grazing box can be collected from 6pm from the Visitor Centre before entering the West Lawn.

Will there be picnic tables?

There are no picnic tables, ticket holders will be allocated a picnic spot (to allow for social distancing) on a first come first served basis . Please bring picnic blankets, low folding/grazing tables or low back seating.

Is alcohol permitted?

We can allow wine or prosecco to be brought. There will be a prosecco van on the lawn for additional purchases. Photo ID may be requested by management or organisers.

Will all proceeds go to charity?

All proceeds from ticket sales will be given to the Community Foundation for Ireland via the Dublin Pride Fund

Is there parking?

Yes, there is free parking on site. The West Lawn is a 3-5 minute walk from the main car park. Malahide DART station is just a 10-minute walk from the West Lawn via the pedestrian entrance from Malahide Village.

What time will the event end?

The event will finish at 9pm for the health and safety of visitors and staff. We ask that ticket holders vacate the West Lawn as soon as possible after the event finishes.

Will there be bins provided?

There will be bins provided on the West Lawn, we kindly ask that all waste is put in bins provided or taken home and the beautiful West Lawn is left as it was found.

Are there toilets on site?

Yes, there are toilets available for use beside the West Lawn. Masks must be worn and social distancing adhered to while queuing at all times.

Can we bring our own picnic food?

Yes, you can bring your own food but please dispose of all rubbish afterwards. No BBQ's permitted.

What happens if there's bad weather?

In the event of bad weather the picnic will be rescheduled for different date. All ticket holders will be contacted by email in advance. There will be no refunds issued as this is a charity event.
